Call to Order:

The LRTP Advisory Committee (LRTP-AC) Chair, Nora Amos, presided and called the October 28, 2021, LRTP AC meeting to order at 9:05 a.m.

1. Consideration of Amendments to the Agenda

There were no requested changes to the meeting agenda. Seeing and hearing no objections, the agenda was approved by acclamation as presented.

2. Approval of September 23, 2021 LRTP-AC Meeting Summary

There were no comments or corrections to the September 23, 2021, LRTP-AC meeting summary.

4. Connect RVA 2045 Parking Lot Items

5. Connect RVA 2045 Citizen's Guide

Chet Parsons, PlanRVA, provided this report to the committee. The Citizen's Guide is being developed and will be made available to the community once it is completed. Committee members are encouraged to provide input on what the focus of the guide will be and other content.

6. Connect RVA 2045 Concluding Discussion

Mr. Aryal asked for input from committee members on how the process can be improved upon going forward. Mr. Parsons announced that a survey will be sent to the committee members asking for input as well.

Thoughts shared by committee members:

• The circle diagram identifying the steps was helpful to committee members in staying focused.

Suggestions for going forward:

• It is important to make sure performance measures that are included are readily identifiable.

- Ensure we are utilizing data that is effective in achieving goals.
- Add values of prioritization as early in the process as possible.
- Expanded environment measures that are available will be considered.
- It is important to see the impact of different values of prioritization.
- The project scoring criteria could include health criteria in the future. A representative from the Virginia Department of Health may be included in the next committee makeup.

7. 2050 LRTP Update

Mr. Parsons announced that the next LRTP is already being discussed. A big component will be scenario planning. It would a great opportunity to include housing and employment factors. Increasing community involvement will be important in the process. Virtual options will be utilized but in-person interaction will be sought wherever possible.

8. Next LRTP Advisory Committee Meeting

Chair Amos noted that this is the last meeting of the of the LRTP Advisory Committee.

Mr. Aryal was thanked for his efforts in coordinating the committee.
