- Walkers have the right-of-way.

- Stay on designated paths.
- Use lights and reflectors when it's dark.
- Keep pets on a leash and clean up after your pet.
- Alcohol, camping, fires are not allowed.

- Unauthorized motorized vehicles not permitted

DESTINATIONS FORM NORTH TO SOUTH

The destination may not be in a particular locality but if it can be accessed from that locality is listed there (e.g. VSU is in Chesterfield, but it can be accessed form Colonial Heights).

GENERAL NOTES:

- Please include the miles to the destinations from the trailheads for on-trail destinations and from the trail to the off-trail destinations.
- The maximum number of characters that can be included:
 - For signs P1 is: 20 characters, counting blank spaces per line (only one line available) when including two symbols,
 22 characters, counting blank spaces per line when including one symbol and 24 characters, counting blank spaces per line without symbols.
 - For Signs P2: 21 characters, counting blank spaces per line (two lines available) when including two symbols, 24 characters, counting blank spaces per line when including one symbol and 26 characters, counting blank spaces per line without symbols.
