1. Attendance

L RTP Project Manager Dorian Allen welcomed everyone and asked that all Advisory Work Group Members record their respective names and affiliations in the Zoom chat to record attendance.

2. January 25, 2026, LRTP-AWG Meeting Summary

Dorian informed the group that the summary of the meeting was included within the agenda packet.

There were no amendments to the meeting summary.

3. Public Comment Period

There were no requests to offer public comment.

4. LRTP Progress Update

Dorian presented a review of the condensed LRTP process flow with an overview and timeline for past and upcoming tasks.

5. LRTP Phase 6: Project Prioritization Methodology

Dorian presented on changes made to the 2050 LRTP Project Prioritization and Methodology document, which included changes to air pollution emissions calculations, safety performance measure and crash weighting, project impact tiering, and SmartScale methodology adherence language.

Mitch Huber asked a clarifying question regarding transit-focused project tiering. The Advisory Workgroup did not have any further comments or questions.

6. LRTP Phase 6: Constrained Long Range Transportation Plan (CLRTP) Development

Myles discussed multiple investment options for AWG public to review before final selection and refinements – going through the four options, three of which consider both benefits and costs (within an Efficiency category) and one that considers only benefits (within a Transformative category).

He next noted information about bridges and rail improvements. He noted that regionally significant bridges are included under programmatic investments as a component of state of good repair, not ranked or scored. For rail improvements, rail revenues are not in the plan and Federal Railroad Administration does not require MPO approvals, so these projects aren't scored but will be included on the Vision list.

Finally, Myles discussed developer, local EDA/General Fund projects which are being purely funded via local funds and/or the development approval process outside of the Universe of Projects, noting that these projects are not scored and are instead they are listed separately and included in CLRTP consistent with previous practice.

Dorian next presented a sample score card that has been used to score each of the projects, explaining the various rows and categories.

He stated that next steps for the CL RTP include refining performance measure outputs (quality control), developing investment scenario packages and one-pagers, finalizing and distributing project scorecards to the AWG, and holding individual stakeholder meetings.

The Advisory Workgroup did not have any comments or questions on this item.

7. Next Meeting

Dorian noted that the next meeting will be on April 8th and this meeting will be held in-person. He said he would follow up with a meeting invitation soon. He stated that additional materials would be distributed by the end of the week, and he will be contacting individuals to set up meeting times shortly as well.
