12. FY24 - FY29 STBG/CMAQ Allocations - Existing Project Requests

Mr. Busching presented this request and offered to answer any questions. Committee members had questions and Mr. Busching clarified that the projects staff did not recommend approval of funding for have been identified as having additional/other funding that can be considered. The funds, if not approved for the requested project, would be available for new project applications. Committee members expressed concerns with the assumption that CVTA local funds could be used for the projects and noted that the localities generally have other projects that are planned for CVTA local funds.

The group reviewed each of the existing project requests. Localities provided detailed explanations on the status and history of each of their respective projects. After discussion, it was decided to postpone action on these projects until the February meeting. That would send it to the Policy Board in March. Liz McAdory noted that VDOT would need the Policy Board decision by mid-March.

There was a consensus to defer action on this matter until the February TAC meeting.

The issue of cost overruns that the Policy Board would like TAC to address was also discussed. It will be on the February TAC agenda. It was suggested that staff have individual discussions with each locality to refine the narrative for each project on the history list.

FFY22 TIER II GROUP TAM PERFORMANCE TARGETS

Richmond Regional Transportation Planning Organization

REQUESTED ACTION: Review and recommend RRTPO Policy Board approval of the FFY22 Tier II Group TAM performance targets and incorporation into the Transportation Improvement Program.

BACKGROUND: The National Transit Asset Management System Final Rule (49 U.S.C. 625) requires transit agencies that receive federal financial assistance under 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53 and own, operate, or manage capital assets used in the provision of public transportation create a Transit Asset Management (TAM) plan. Transit agencies can fulfill this requirement through an individual or group plan.

The Department of Rail and Public Transportation (DRPT) sponsors a Tier II Group TAM Plan for Tier II transit agencies. A Tier II transit agency is a subrecipient of FTA 5311 funds, or is an American Indian Tribe, or has 100 or fewer vehicles across all fixed route modes, or has 100 vehicles or less in 1 non-fixed route mode.

DRPT published a new FFY22 Virginia Group Tier II Transit Asset Management Plan on October 1, 2022, after The Plan was adopted by the 33 transit agencies who were eligible to participate in the plan. Bay Transit which serves the eastern counties in the region is a participating Tier II agency. The RRTPO can elect to follow the group plan performance targets or to set regionally developed targets.

FY21 – FY24 TIP AMENDMENT: UPC 122805: I-64 GAP IMPROVEMENTS – SEGMENT A

Richmond Regional Transportation Planning Organization

REQUESTED ACTION: Review and provide a recommendation to the policy board on a request from VDOT to amend the FY21 – FY24 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add funding obligations and additional phases to an existing project

BACKGROUND: The RRTPO Policy Board has received a request from VDOT to amend the TIP to revise the planned obligations on UPC 122805: I-64 Gap Improvements – Segment A. The project currently has the preliminary engineering (PE) phase programmed in the TIP. The proposed amendment would add state funding for right-of-way (\$1,000,000) and construction (\$249,813,744), both in fiscal year 2023. As a state funded project, there is no impact on *federal* funding obligations.

Major work proposed in this project includes:

- 2 bridge widening/rehabilitations (EB/WB I-64 over Route 155 N. Courthouse Road)
- 10.7 miles of I-64 roadway widening and pavement rehabilitation within the existing right-of-way
- Overhead signage and ITS Systems
- Sound Barrier Walls
- Retaining Walls
- Box Culvert and Pipe Repairs
- Storm Drainage Box Culverts and Pipes

A request for proposals for this project is expected this spring with a design-build contract award scheduled for this fall. The proposed amendments are necessary for the project to advance.

ACTION REQUESTED: The following resolution is presented for consideration and recommendation to the Policy Board:

RESOLVED, that the Richmond Regional Transportation Planning Organization Policy Board amends the *FY21 – FY24 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)* to revise the planned obligations on UPC 122805: I-64 GAP IMPROVEMENTS – SEGMENT A to include:

- \$1,000,000 in Other (State) funding for Right-of-Way in fiscal year 2023
- \$249,813,744 in Other (State) funding for Construction in fiscal year 2023

PROJECT COST ESTIMATING

Richmond Regional Transportation Planning Organization

REQUESTED ACTION: Review historic project estimating performance and recommend any necessary changes to the policy board to reduce the impacts of cost overruns on regional funding programs

BACKGROUND: Selecting and prioritizing projects for funding is one of the primary roles of the RRTPO in developing the regional transportation system. Projects selected by the TPO to receive funding are included in the Six-Year Improvement Program (SYIP) for adoption by the Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB).

In developing the FY23 – FY28 allocations plans, VDOT identified large shortfalls on three projects that had not been previously requested through the TPO application process. In total, these shortfalls totaled over \$13 million. To meet these existing project needs, no new projects were selected for the second year in a row.

The RRTPO policy board directed staff to review the performance of the STBG and CMAQ programs and identify opportunities to reduce cost overruns and their impacts on regional funding programs. Staff reviewed all active projects based on the SYIP estimates by phase over time. Staff presented the requested information at the January policy board meeting. The <u>presentation materials can be found here</u>.

Of the 39 projects analyzed, staff found the median project was about 26% over the original estimate and TPO funding had increased by about 19%. These figures are within the AASHTO expected range for cost increases on projects selected in the planning phase.

Staff also identified a handful of mostly legacy projects which negatively impact the program. The cost of 11 (28%) projects has at least doubled for the original estimate, with 6 of them dating to the 2000s or earlier. On 8 (20%) projects, the TPO's funding commitment had at least doubled over the life of the project. In several cases, the estimate increases were driven by evolving project scopes (for example, the Mayo Bridge project started as a rehabilitation and evolved into a replacement).

The policy board has referred this question of how to address cost estimating and overruns to TAC with the following requests:

- 1. Provide an explanation for the cost increases in all cases where an active or recently completed project has exceeded its original budget (requested last month), and
- 2. Determine what policy changes are needed (if any) to reduce cost overruns and their impacts on regional funding programs. Some options to consider include:
 - a. Using more conservative estimate assumptions (like Smart Scale)
 - b. Increasing project definition before selection (e.g., requiring 30% design)
 - c. Reducing TPO exposure to overruns by awarding funds for a single phase or fixed dollar amounts

d. Improving time to delivery

FY24 - FY29 STBG/CMAQ EXISTING PROJECT REQUESTS

REQUESTED ACTION: Review existing project requests and provide a recommendation on FY24 – FY29 STBG/CMAQ funding awards

BACKGROUND: Selecting and prioritizing projects for funding is one of the primary roles of the RRTPO in developing the regional transportation system. Projects selected by the TPO to receive funding are included in the Six-Year Improvement Program (SYIP) for adoption by the Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB).

In June of 2021, the RRTPO Policy Board adopted new guidelines for project selection and allocation of regional Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) and Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funds. The newly adopted guidelines can be reviewed on the PlanRVA website.

The RRTPO held an existing project request application period in September. A total of eleven (11) applications were submitted for additional funding. A summary of the requests is included as Attachment A.

Based on the discussion at the October TAC meeting, staff have had additional discussions with project sponsors to understand the requests. Staff has also compiled a project history back to 2004 (where necessary) using the Six-Year Improvement Program.

A summary of the requests and the staff analysis from the January 2023 meeting are included as attachments to this report as reference materials.

TAC ACTION REQUESTED: TAC is requested to provide a funding recommendation on each project for incorporation into the draft funding allocation plans along with new projects if sufficient funding is available.


This spring, the Policy Board gave staff direction to reduce the cost of overruns to the TPO, including a review of the cost estimating practices of project sponsors and policies for prioritizing existing project requests. As noted in the main staff report, RRTPO staff have concerns about the use of STBG funds to address project deficits when no other funding sources have been sought. Staff remind localities of the general requirement to address increases using local funds where available.

Staff also remind sponsors of the financial programming practice of fully funding existing projects before funding new projects. As partners in the project funding and development process, the expectation is that local sponsors will also prioritize existing projects in the development pipeline when programming local transportation funding.

Staff has reviewed each project request against the SYIP and TPO allocation history and provided a general recommendation consistent with the *Regional Funding Framework* guidelines and Policy Board direction.




As discussed last year, this project has experienced rapid increases in cost over the past few years, well beyond the impact of inflation. Since FY2019, the project estimate has increased by more than \$21 million, a 148% increase in cost. The TPO has funded nearly half of this increase, increasing the regionally funded portion of the project from less than 15% to more than 24%. With the current request, the TPO share of the cost would increase further to 35%. Staff have significant concerns about continuing to increase the TPO share of a project that has grown well above the original estimate and where the sponsor has requested \$3M+ in additional funding in 3 of the past 5 cycles.

As the TPO has covered a disproportionate share of the recent increases, Staff recommend no additional TPO funding be awarded to this project.

If additional funding is awarded, staff recommend a partial award of \$1,360,025 to maintain the same cost share. Staff further recommend the funds be awarded contingent upon the project beginning delivery in FY25.


Staff Recommendation: As with the previous project above, staff have concerns about the timeline and uncertainty around this project. This project was previously advertised in FY19. At the time, the project was fully funded and was scheduled for completion in FY21. The project did not ultimately move to construction. Since that time, the estimate has increased by 56%.

The City of Richmond has found additional funding to cover a portion of the cost increase, however, the pending request would increase TPO funding on this project by another 22%. While this project has been largely TPO funded, TAC should consider the appropriateness of the TPO taking on additional costs for given the failure to deliver the project during the previous bid cycle. The estimate submitted in the application is below the revised six-year program estimate (\$22.016M), raising additional concerns about the ability to move this project to construction as scheduled.

Given the post-bid history, Staff recommend no additional TPO funding be awarded to this project. If additional funding is awarded, Staff recommend the funds be awarded contingent upon the project beginning delivery in FY24.

REGIONAL CONFORMITY ASSESSMENT PROJECT LIST

Richmond Regional Transportation Planning Organization

REQUESTED ACTION: Review the draft list of projects from the FY24 – FY27 Transportation Improvement Program and ConnectRVA 2045 for air quality conformity analysis and provide a recommendation to the policy board.

BACKGROUND: As part of the FY24 – FY27 TIP development, the Richmond-Petersburg Area is required to demonstrate conformity under the Clean Air Act (CAA). While in attainment for all current emissions standards, the region was a nonattainment area, and later a maintenance area, for the 1997 8-hour ozone standard. In 2018, the D.C. Circuit Court issued a decision in South Coast Air Quality Management District v. EPA which requires all nonattainment or maintenance areas under the 1997 standards to demonstrate conformity for the LRTP and the TIP, even when in attainment under the more stringent 2015 standards. The constrained list of projects in the ConnectRVA 2045 plan along with the ungrouped projects in the draft FY24-27 TIP that are located within the former 8-hour ozone maintenance area will constitute the RRTPO set of projects for this analysis. Staff is finalizing review of the project list with VDOT and DRPT; the attached list may be updated for the meeting.

The interagency consultation meeting is scheduled to take place before the March 14, 2023, TAC meeting. To accommodate the STIP development schedule, the proposed resolution would also authorize the TAC to review the conformity report and draft TIP and open public comment on both documents. The public review period is scheduled to run concurrently for both reports.

TAC ACTION REQUESTED: The following resolution is presented to TAC consideration and recommendation to the policy board:

RESOLVED, that the Richmond Regional Transportation Planning Organization policy board approves the attached list of ungrouped projects from the draft FY24 – FY27 Transportation Improvement Program and ConnectRVA 2045 as the universe of RRTPO projects for air quality conformity analysis as required by federal regulations (23 CFR § 450.326).

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the RRTPO policy board authorizes the TAC to review and open public comment on the draft FY24 – FY27 TIP and Regional Conformity Assessment at the March 14, 2023, meeting.
