








Demographics: Population Change

















Region-Wide trend among population of different races









Share of Non-White and White population by locality














Region-Wide trend among age groups





Growth/Decline across age brackets (2010 – 2020)







% Difference in Median Household Income by locality (2012-2022), corrected for inflation


















Housing: Cost Burdened Household - Owner Occupied








Housing: Cost Burdened Household - Renter Occupied















Housing: Affordability at Income of 150% AMI (Area Median Income)








Housing: Affordability at Income of 120% AMI (Area Median Income)








Housing: Affordability at Income of 100% AMI (Area Median Income)








Housing: Affordability at Income of 80% AMI (Area Median Income)




