

What is CTAC:

CTAC is the Community Transportation Advisory Committee.

Composition:

CTAC is comprised of representatives from each of the nine localities in the region as well as community-based organizations.

CTAC Role/responsibilities:

- A committee of the RRTPO, CTAC advises the RRTPO Policy Board on issues, plans, studies, and matters necessary and appropriate for providing viable and reasonable citizen input.
- Alongside staff, CTAC is responsible for:
 - Assisting development of and revisions to the RRTPO's public engagement plan, a federally required plan that shapes all outreach efforts. Assisting in the development of project-specific engagement strategies for each major planning project and gathering input during specified public comment period. The biggest example of this is the Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP).
 - Assisting in the development of engagement strategies for the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and gathering input during public comment periods on funding-related decisions.
 - Assisting in the development of community events for RRTPO promotional activities. CTAC members will take a direct role in representing the agency along with staff at public events.
