



Community Transportation Advisory Committee (CTAC)

Purpose

The Richmond Regional Transportation Planning Organization (RRTPO) powered by PlanRVA, is a federally mandated and federally funded transportation policy-making organization. It was created to ensure regional cooperation in transportation planning.

The Community Transportation Advisory Committee (CTAC) advises the RRTPO on issues, plans, and matters appropriate for citizen input and ensures we're connecting to and engaging with the diverse people in our region.

Alongside staff, it is also responsible for:

- Leading development of and revisions to the RRTPO's public engagement plan, a federally required plan that shapes all outreach efforts.
- Assisting in the development of project-specific engagement strategies for major planning projects and gathering input during specified public comment period.
- Assisting in the development of community events for RRTPO promotional activities.
- CTAC members will take a direct role in representing the agency along with staff at public events.

CTAC is comprised of representatives from each of the nine localities in the region as well as community-based organizations.
