Regional Conformity Assessment

- FY 27-30 TIP and 2050 LRTP development must demonstrate Clean Air Act conformity.
- Richmond-Petersburg region **currently meets** all **federal air quality standards**.
 - Formerly a non-attainment/maintenance area.
 - 2018 court ruling requires ongoing conformity determinations despite attainment of newer ozone standards.

Regional Conformity Assessment

- Contains projects within ConnectRVA 2050 constrained project list & ungrouped projects from the amended draft FY 27-30 TIP
 - Within former 8-hr ozone maintenance area.
 - RRTPO PB approved the amended 27-30 TIP project list at their July 2nd meeting.

Regional Conformity Assessment

- Draft conformity report was approved at the Interagency Consultation meeting on Aug. 7, 2026.
- Pending TAC approval, 30-day public comment period open from Aug. 17th until Sept. 18th.

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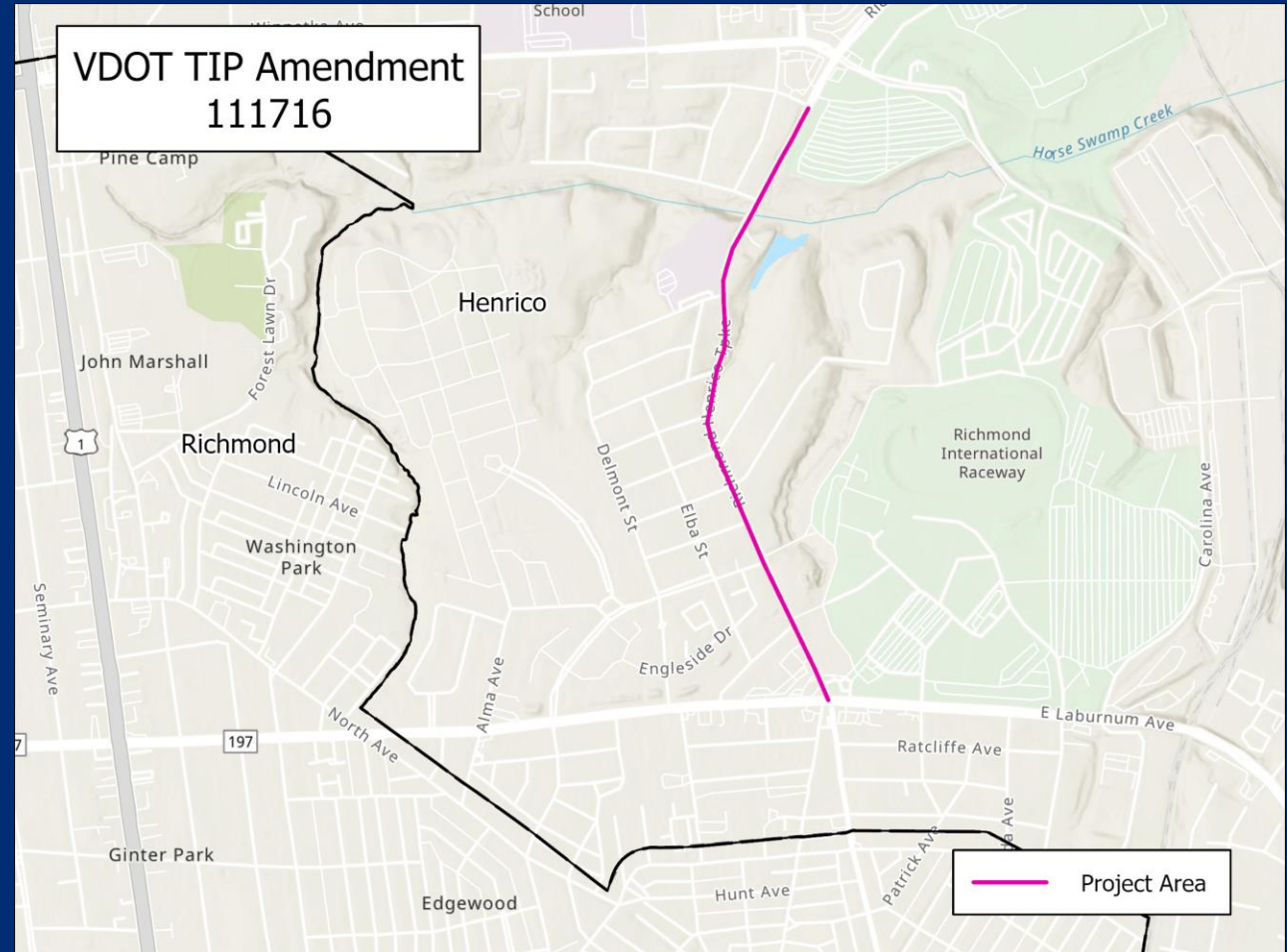
Background



- Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) plans investments and federal obligations for next 4 years
- VDOT has made a request to amend the TIP to update funding for the existing Richmond-Henrico Turnpike Southern Segment project (UPC 111716).
- This project stems from a successful SMART SCALE RD 2 bid by Henrico County in FY 2018.

Project Overview

- Widen Richmond-Henrico Tpke to a 4 lane, divided roadway.
 - From Laburnum Ave to Hummingbird Rd.
- Sidewalks added to the western side of the tpke.
- Shared-Use path constructed to the eastern side.
