### Overview

- Selecting projects for suballocated STBG and CMAQ funds is a primary responsibility of the RRTPO
- Sponsors can request new projects or additional funding for existing projects
- Existing projects generally prioritized over new projects
- Framework provides specific guidance for cost increases



### Framework Guidance

- Sponsors able to request additional funding but should <u>use local or other outside funds first</u>
- Requests greater than 10% of initial allocations require TAC recommendation and policy board approval; TAC approves requests up to 10%
- TAC can recommend combination of:
  - Scale back the project
  - Use local or other non-RRTPO funds (partial or full)
  - Use balance entry funds (partial or full)
  - Deselect project (if not started)

# Available Funding

- Updated budget for FY23 FY28 not yet available
- Staff updated estimates of available funding based on recent transfers/closeouts, reserve policy, and FY22 budget numbers
- Approximately \$7.3M available FY23 FY27 without impacting reserves
- Remaining requests total \$11.3M
- Additional funds expected for FY28, but already committed for next phase of other existing projects

### TA Set-Aside Project Selections

TAC Meeting February 8, 2022



### Overview

- Transportation Alternatives program is funding primarily for bicycle and pedestrian projects
- Funding set aside from larger Surface
   Transportation Block Grant (STBG) program
- Program also includes Safe Routes to Schools programs



### Prioritization Process

- Prioritization specified in Regional Project Framework document
- 80% based on statewide merit score
- 10% based on equity emphasis areas served
- 10% based on inclusion of project or corridor in regional bike or ped networks (2004 plan)
- Cost-benefit for final ranking



## **Budget Consideration**

- Available funding not provided by VDOT
- MPO must make selections by March or be responsible for holding own public hearings
- VDOT recommendation is to use FY22 funding as baseline for selections
- Staff held funding at FY22 level for both years to develop draft project selections

### SRTS Inclusion

- Safe Routes to Schools <u>non-infrastructure</u> programs included in TA candidate pool for the first time
- SRTS program is top scoring project based on framework methodology
- Draft resolution includes funding for SRTS program

### VDOT Transfer Request – UPC 97688

TAC Meeting February 8, 2022



### Overview

- This project is the first link of the Courthouse-to-Courthouse trail in Charles City County
- Project was completed last year, but is over budget by \$88,857
- Overrun due to unsuitable subgrade that required additional excavation and stone backfill
- Request is to transfer previous funds to cover the overrun so the project can be closed out



### Framework Guidance

- Sponsors able to request additional funding but should use local or other outside funds first
- Requests less than 10% of current allocations are approved by TAC
- TAC can approve combination of:
  - Use local or other non-RRTPO funds (partial or full)
  - Use STBG balance entry funds (partial or full)



### Staff Recommendation

- Staff recommends approval of the transfer to complete the project
- Project is fully funded by the TPO
- Staff has worked with VDOT to ensure sufficient balance was available to cover this request



### Requested Action

Review and approval of the following resolution

**Resolved**, that the Richmond Regional Transportation Planning Organization (RRTPO) approves the transfer of \$88,857 in previous regional Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) and match funds from the balance entry (UPC 70721) to the Rt 155 Shared Use Path project (UPC 97688)
