MEETING NOTES

- Mr. Diesta discussed hospital system vulnerabilities in Goochland, especially with regard to high winds.
- Ms. Tippet mentioned flooding in South Richmond and Chesterfield, road damage/inaccessibility/closure, and flooding in Cloverfield community. She recently saw roads flood that hadn't flooded before and was concerned. She indicated Prevention mitigation actions are most important, including buyouts in flood zones.
- Mr. Stewart indicated Education & Awareness actions are most important for resilience.
- Mr. King emphasized importance of making certain that materials are available for ESL citizens and that there is no misinformation therein, citing some COVID 19 info for Spanish-speaking Virginians that was incorrect.
- Additional discussion ensued regarding:
 - the compound effects of disasters;
 - educating out-of-towners (whether college students or tourists) on emergency protection measures;
 - microgrids for electrical power storage and reallocation, particularly with regard to health systems.
- Virginia National Guard is involved in ongoing multi-year study, supported by FEMA, of health care facilities and power grid(s).

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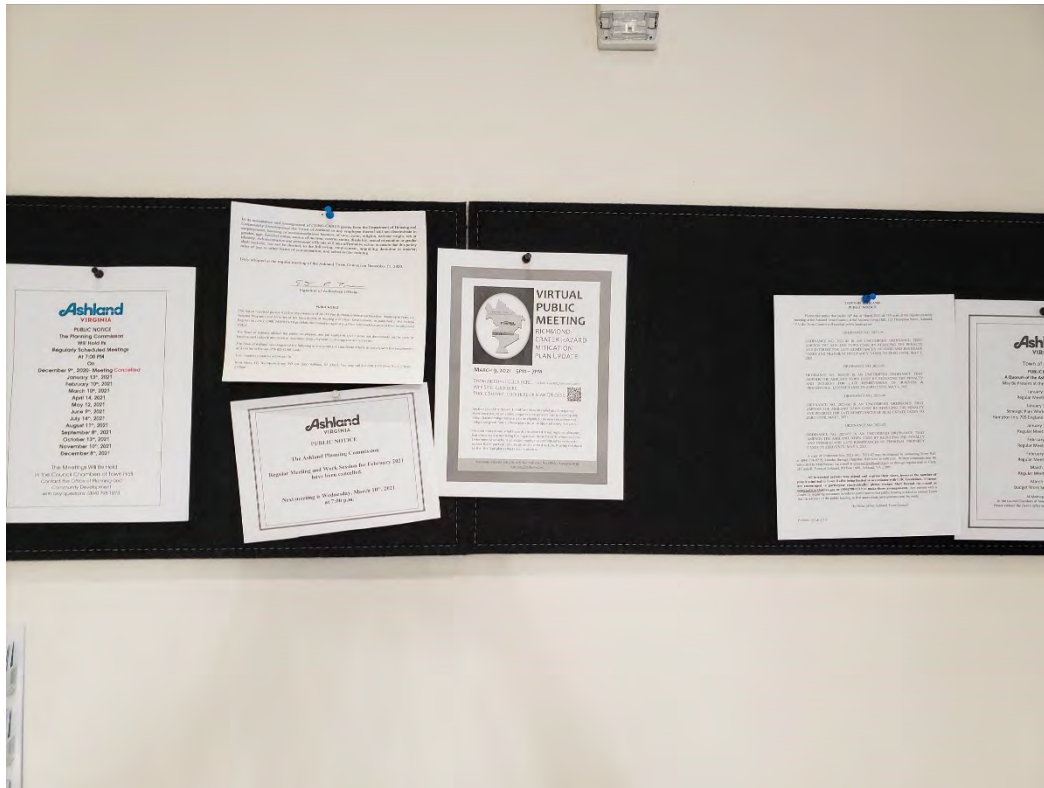

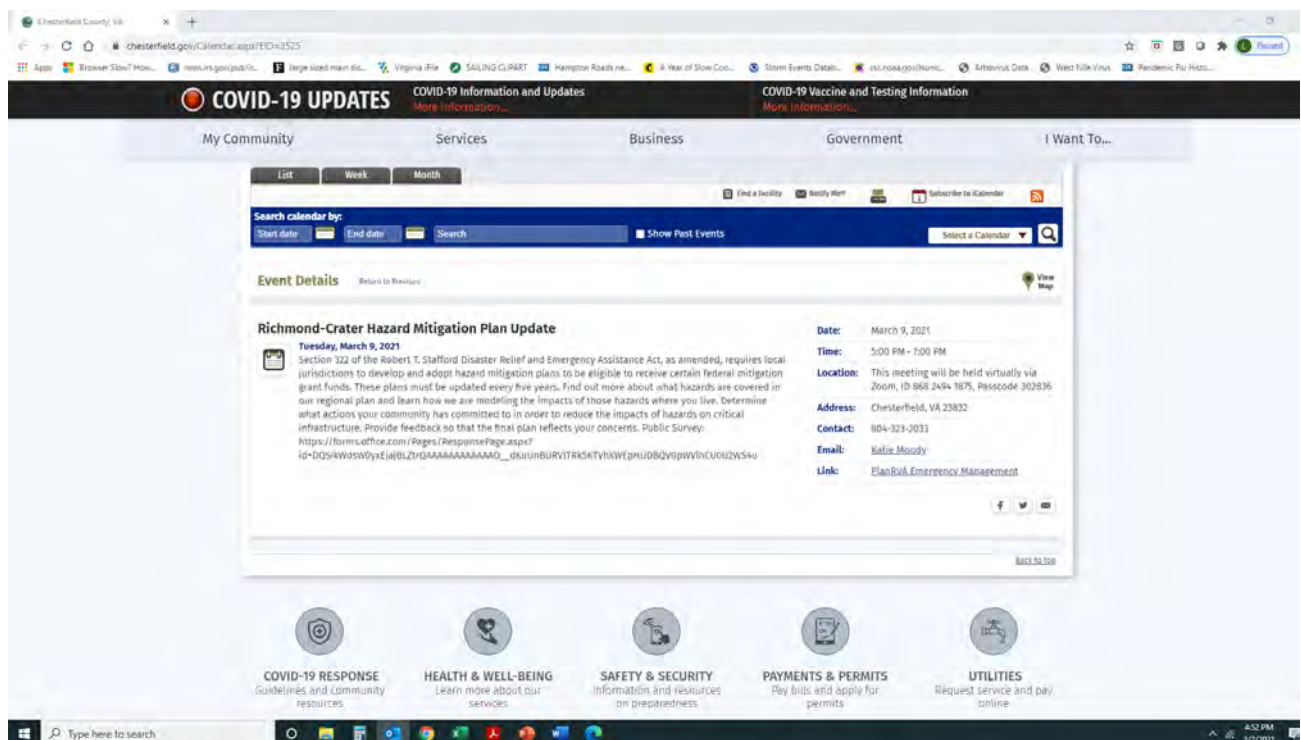



Hazard mitigation planning is a process undertaken to reduce loss of life and property by lessening the potential impact of future disasters. The 22 localities of the Richmond and Crater regions work together to update the Richmond-Crater Multi-Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan every five years. The plan identifies vulnerabilities associated with a variety of hazards and sets out long-term strategies to reduce or eliminate risks. While little can be done to wholly prevent natural hazard events from occurring, the plan helps ensure the region is poised to minimize the disruption that so often accompanies disasters, thereby increasing resilience.

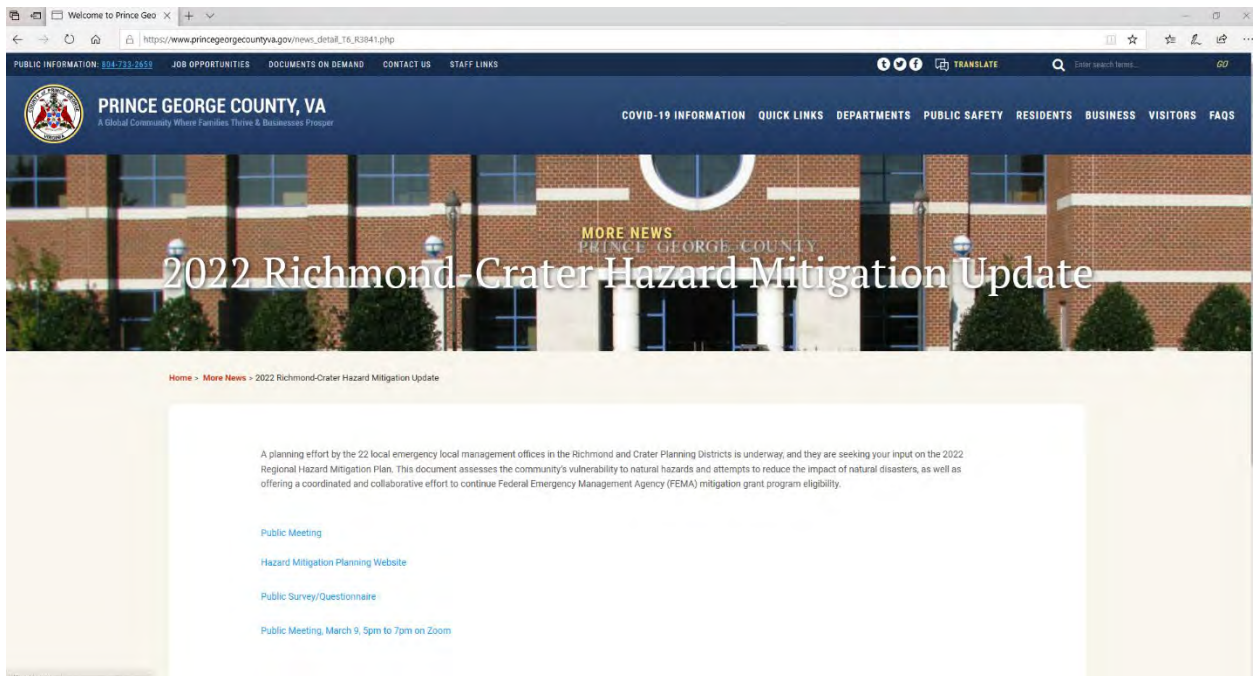
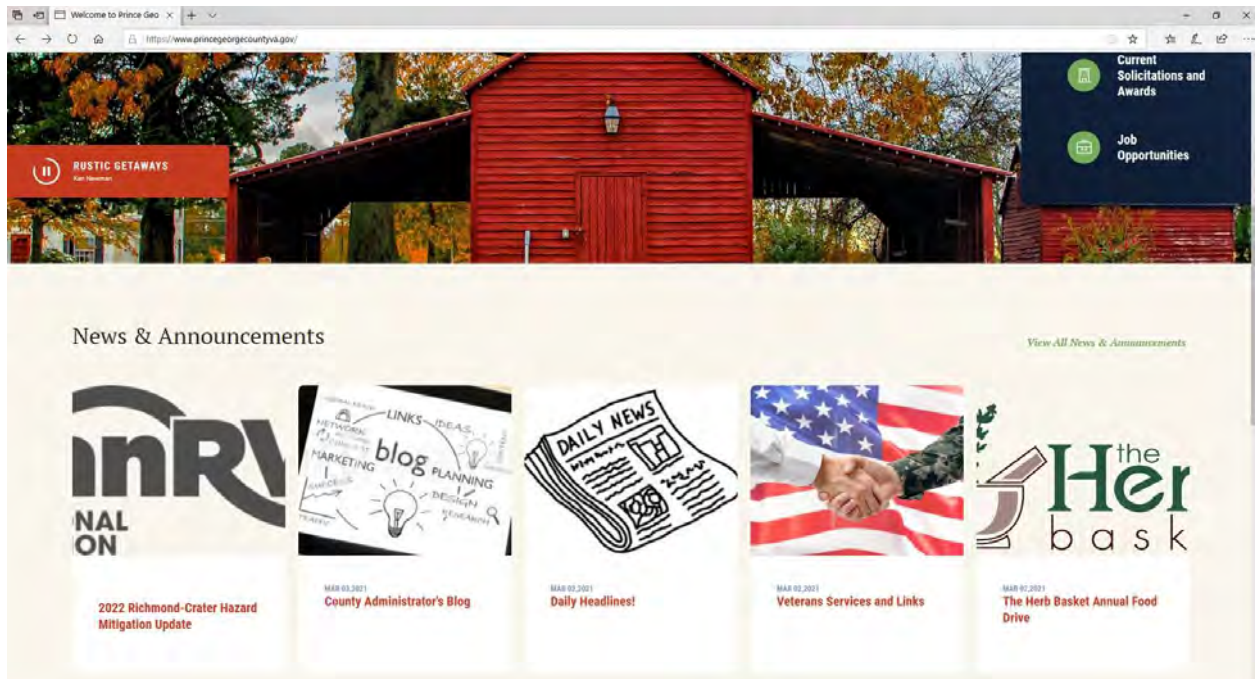

The Community Rating System (CRS)
The CRS is a national program developed by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to encourage communities to reduce their risk to flood-related hazards. The CRS rewards communities that go above and beyond the minimum requirements of the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) by providing discounts on flood insurance premiums.
