The RRTPO LRTP Advisory Committee meeting was held by electronic communication means as set forth by the April 22, 2020 actions of the General Assembly in response to the continued spread of novel coronavirus, or COVID-19. The technology used for this meeting was a web-hosted service created by Zoom and YouTube Live Streaming and was open and accessible for participation by members of the public. Call to Order:

The LRTP Advisory Committee Chair, Andrew Pompei, presided and called the February 25, 2021 LRTP meeting to order at 9:01 a.m.

1. Consideration of Amendments to the Agenda

There were no requested changes to the meeting agenda. Seeing and hearing no objections, the agenda was approved by acclamation as presented.

2. Approval of January 28, 2021 LRTP-AC Meeting Summary

There were no comments or corrections to the January 28, 2021 LRTP-AC meeting summary. The LRTP Advisory Committee unanimously approved the meeting summary of the January 28, 2021 meeting by acclamation as presented.

3. Public Comment Period

There were no requests to address the LRTP Advisory Committee.

4. LRTP Process Update Task 3: Planning

a. Universe of Projects – First Look

RRTPO staff completed the first draft of the regionally significant projects across all modes which are called the 'Universe of Projects". These projects were screened based on the Project Inclusion Guidelines and the list was distributed to the committee members on February 23rd. Projects in this list will be evaluated, scored, ranked and prioritized to be in the 'Constrained List of Projects. Projects that do not make the cut will be listed in the 'Vision List of Projects'.

A brief presentation was given on the projects included in each category: Highway, Bridge, Transit, Active Transportation, Park and Ride and Rail. Project cost estimates were considered based on the transportation needs by project type and currently total \$7.28 Billion.

<u>Next Steps</u>: Staff will coordinate with the Project Champions and the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) to revise and complete the development of the Universe of Projects list. Comments should be submitted by committee members and Project Champions by March 15th. Public comments will be invited during the 15-day public comment period from March 8th - March 22nd. A final draft of the list excluding public comments will be distributed to the committee and Project Champions on March 18th. Endorsement of the Universe of Projects by the committee will be requested at the next meeting on March 25th.

5. LRTP Process Update Task 4: Programming

a. Fiscally Constrained Plan Development

Task 4 will be comparing the revenues to costs and demonstrating that the revenue projections are sufficient to operate and maintain the existing transportation system, implement the proposed transportation system improvements (prioritization of projects if not sufficient) and set aside revenue for local or programmatic projects.

<u>Next Steps</u>: Forecasted revenues will be determined by considering VDOT, DRPT, CVTA and private/local funding sources. More information on future revenue estimates through 2045 received from VDOT and DRPT will be an item on the agenda at the March meeting.

6. LRTP Process Update Task 5: Evaluation of the Constrained Plan

After the Fiscally Constrained Plan is approved by the RRTPO Policy Board, Richmond Region's first performance-based plan will be evaluated based on the following:

- 5.0 Base Year Transportation Performance Reports and Targets
- 5.1 ConnectRVA Performance Measures Evaluation
- 5.2 Economic Impact Analysis (EIA)
- 5.3 Environmental Justice Analysis
- 5.4 Accessibility Assessment
- 5.5 Air Quality Conformity/Interagency Consultation
- 5.6 Public Participation Evaluation

7. Next LRTP Advisory Committee Meeting

Chairman Pompei noted the next meeting will be held on March 25, 2021. The meeting was adjourned at 10:01 a.m. on February 25, 2021.
