Others Present:

The RRTPO LRTP Advisory Committee meeting was held by electronic communication means as set forth by the April 22, 2020 actions of the General Assembly in response to the continued spread of novel coronavirus, or COVID-19. The technology used for this meeting was a web-hosted service created by Zoom and YouTube Live Streaming and was open and accessible for participation by members of the public. Call to Order:

The LRTP Advisory Committee Chair, Andrew Pompei, presided and called the April 22, 2021 LRTP meeting to order at 9:03 a.m.

1. Consideration of Amendments to the Agenda

There were no requested changes to the meeting agenda. Seeing and hearing no objections, the agenda was approved by acclamation as presented.

2. Approval of March 25, 2021 LRTP-AC Meeting Summary

There were no comments or corrections to the March 25, 2021 LRTP-AC meeting summary. The LRTP Advisory Committee unanimously approved the meeting summary of the March 25, 2021 meeting by acclamation as presented.

3. Public Comment Period

There were no requests to address the LRTP Advisory Committee.

4. LRTP Process Update Task 3: Planning

a. Universe of Projects – Public Comments

RRTPO staff has finalized the master list of potential regionally significant projects, the 'Universe of Projects". These projects were screened based on the Project Inclusion Guidelines. In response to public requests for additional review time, the public engagement period for the draft Universe of Projects was extended to April 15, 2021. A total of 999 public comments have been received. Staff reviewed all comments and worked with the project sponsors and the Champions to determine the impact of these comments on the Universe of Projects list. A summary of the projects added, and projects removed was provided. The full Universe of Projects includes 268 projects; the total cost of needs identified is \$7.69 Billion (three I-95 projects don't have cost estimates yet).

On motion of John Leonard, seconded by Joseph E. Vidunas, the Richmond Regional Transportation Planning Organization (RRTPO) ConnectRVA 2045 Advisory Committee approved the following resolution as presented (16-Y 0-N 1-A; see Appendix A):

RESOLVED, that the Richmond Regional Transportation Planning Organization (RRTPO) ConnectRVA 2045 Advisory Committee approves the Universe of Projects as presented and authorizes staff to begin the testing process to score,

rank, and prioritize the Universe of Projects into a refined draft cost constrained project list.

5. LRTP Process Update Task 4: Programming

a. Budget Allocations Survey

In an effort to continue making online public engagement options available to keep the public informed and involved, a new MetroQuest survey was launched on April 16th. A demonstration on the latest survey called Budget Allocations was given. The public is asked to weigh in on funding decisions: How should our region spend transportation funds? The MetroQuest reporting tool will allow staff to summarize the results after the survey closes on May 14th and share them with the committee at a future meeting. Staff thanked VDOT for the invitation to use the MetroQuest platform.

6. LRTP Schedule/Public Engagement

Staff is getting closer to the home stretch of the long-range plan development. Over the next few weeks, staff will conduct model runs on all the projects and will compile the data to develop the Constrained List of Projects. There will then be another 30-day public review period in late May/early June, and a final draft of the Constrained List of Projects will come before the committee for approval.

The final draft plan will go into yet another formal public review period in August/September before it comes back to the committee for approval in September/October. Before the plan can be adopted at the end of October, staff will coordinate with VDOT on conformity requirements and other needed steps.

Staff thanked the Advisory Committee for their continued support and engagement.
