The RRTPO LRTP Advisory Committee meeting was held by electronic communication means as set forth by the April 22, 2020 actions of the General Assembly in response to the continued spread of novel coronavirus, or COVID-19. The technology used for this meeting was a web-hosted service created by Zoom and YouTube Live Streaming and was open and accessible for participation by members of the public. Call to Order:

RRTPO Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) Chair, Nora Amos, presided and called the June 2, 2021 LRTP AC meeting to order at 2:02 p.m.

1. Consideration of Amendments to the Agenda

There were no requested changes to the meeting agenda. Seeing and hearing no objections, the agenda was approved by acclamation as presented.

2. Approval of April 22, 2021 LRTP-AC Meeting Summary

There were no comments or corrections to the April 22, 2021 LRTP-AC meeting summary. On motion of Kathryn Benedict, seconded by John O'Keeffe, the LRTP Advisory Committee unanimously approved the summary of the April 22, 2021 meeting by acclamation as presented (voice vote).

3. Public Comment Period

There were no requests to address the LRTP Advisory Committee.

4. LRTP Process Update Task 4: Programming

a. Universe of Projects Scoring Results

Staff conducted model runs on all 243 projects and compiled the data to develop the draft Constrained List of Projects. The <u>Universe of Projects</u> scorecard results were presented. Staff will schedule meetings with each of the project Champions of the member jurisdictions to review the scores and the staff recommended constrained list of projects.

- b. Budget Allocation Survey Results In an effort to continue making online public engagement options available to keep the public informed and involved, a new MetroQuest survey was launched on April 16th. The public was asked to weigh in on funding decisions: How should our region spend transportation funds? The survey closed on May 14th, and staff summarized the results and presented them to the committee.
- c. Constrained Plan Budget

Staff walked the committee through the process of the constrained budget development. The planned investments cover the entire plan period from 2022 through 2045 with a budget of approximately \$20.5 billion. A breakdown over 6-year periods (current 2022-2027, near-term 2028-2033, mid-term 2034-2039, and long-term 2040-2045) for the projected revenues was provided based on information from recent studies and historic growth patterns. The investments were divided among programmatic expenses and investments (maintenance and operations), local capital investments, and regional projects.

- d. Staff Recommended Constrained List of Projects
 - Projects in the constrained plan are normally listed based on their scored rank; the methods used to select the rank cut-off threshold were provided (224 projects made it to the constrained list). There will be another public review period in early June, and a final draft of the Constrained List of Projects will come before the committee for a recommendation of approval at their June 24th meeting.
