WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

The Central Virginia Transportation Authority (CVTA) Fall Line Working Group Chair, Todd Eure, called the February 1, 2022, CVTA Fall Line Working Group meeting to order at 9:12 a.m.

a. State budget updates

Shane Mann reported that there isn't a specific update on the budget at this point. .

b. Design guidelines

Liz McAdory provided this report. The first stakeholder meeting will be this Thursday. The consultant has been doing peer reviews and will present general ideas and concepts that should be kept in mind.

The goal is to be complete by early May.

c. Proposed design/bid project to deliver combined segments of the trail

Mr. Mann reported that a single mid-sized design build project this calendar year has been deemed the best option for this year. VDOT is awaiting guidance and feedback from this working group as to what the group would like VDOT to look at as an initial project.

There was discussion about the mid-sized project (roughly 25 million) and whether a Capital Trail segment could be a possibility. The recommended project should not have a lot of right-of-way issues so projects along the Dominion line would be good candidates.

5. Locality updates on jurisdiction Fall Line Trail projects

Chair Eure led this discussion on a number of Fall Line Trail projects. Mr. Parsons noted that staff is reviewing FY23-FY26 projects and some of those are Fall Line projects.
