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Executive Summary

This report¹ documents that the Richmond 2045 Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) and fiscal year (FY) 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) developed by the Richmond Regional Transportation Planning Organization (RRTPO)², have met all applicable federal (40 CFR Parts 51 and 93), state and local requirements for transportation conformity. Accordingly, a finding of conformity for the LRTP and TIP is supported. The Richmond Region encompasses portions of the RRTPO and Tri-Cities Metropolitan Planning Organization (TCAMPO). The TCAMPO is not updating nor amending their TIP or LRTP at this time.

Clean Air Act (CAA) section 176(c) (42 U.S.C. 7506(c)) requires that federally funded or approved highway and transit activities be consistent with ("conform to") the purpose of the State Implementation Plan (SIP). Conformity to the purpose of the SIP means that transportation activities will not cause or contribute to new air quality violations, worsen existing violations, or delay timely attainment of the relevant NAAQS or any interim milestones (42 U.S.C. 7506(c)(1)). EPA's transportation conformity rules establish the criteria and procedures for determining whether metropolitan transportation plans, TIPs, and federally supported highway and transit projects conform to the SIP (40 CFR Parts 51.390 and 93).

Notwithstanding the revocation of the 1997 ozone national ambient air quality standard (NAAQS) by EPA effective April 6, 2015, the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit in South Coast Air Quality Mgmt. District v. EPA ("South Coast II," 882 F.3d 1138) held in its decision on February 16, 2018 that transportation conformity determinations must be made in all areas nation-wide that were either nonattainment or maintenance for the 1997 ozone NAAQS and attainment for the 2008 ozone NAAQS when the 1997 ozone NAAQS was revoked. The reinstated conformity requirements were subsequently made effective February 16, 20193. The Richmond region (which encompasses portions of both the RRTPO and TCAMPO) met both conditions: 1) it was in maintenance for the 1997 ozone NAAQS revocation at the time of its revocation by EPA, and 2) at that time had already been designated attainment (on May 21, 2012) for the 2008 ozone NAAQS. Therefore, per the South Coast II decision, and notwithstanding the revocation by EPA of the applicable NAAQS, conformity requirements for the 1997 ozone NAAQS again apply for the prior Richmond eight-hour Ozone Maintenance Area. This conformity assessment was conducted following EPA guidance⁴ issued pursuant to the court decision.

1.0 Background

The Clean Air Act (CAA) Amendments of 1977 included a provision (Section 176(c)) to ensure that transportation investments "conform" to a State implementation plan (SIP) for meeting the Federal air quality standards. Conformity requirements were made substantially more rigorous in the CAA Amendments of 1990. The transportation conformity regulations that detail implementation of the CAA requirements were first issued in November 1993, and have been amended several times⁵. The regulations establish the criteria and procedures for transportation agencies to demonstrate that air pollutant emissions from metropolitan transportation plans (MTPs)⁶, TIPs and projects are consistent with ("conform to") the State's air quality goals in the SIP.

Transportation conformity establishes the framework for improving air quality to protect public health and the environment. Conformity to the purpose of the SIP means Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and Federal Transit Administration (FTA) funding and approvals are given to highway and transit activities that will not cause new air quality violations, worsen existing air quality violations, or delay timely attainment of the relevant air quality standard, or any interim milestone.

2.0 Richmond Region Air Quality Planning Status

On June 1, 2007, the United State Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) approved via Federal Register notice a re-designation request and State Implementation Plan (SIP) revision (maintenance plan) pertaining to the 1997 eighthour ozone standard (2007 SIP) that had been submitted by the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (VDEQ)⁷. EPA also found adequate and approved motor vehicle emission budgets for ozone precursors (nitrogen oxides or NOx, and volatile organic compounds, or VOC) as specified in the maintenance plan. Pursuant to the requirements of the federal conformity rule, the maintenance plan budgets were to be met in future regional conformity analyses for the Richmond area. The designated maintenance area included the counties of Hanover, Henrico, Charles City, Prince George, Chesterfield and the cities of Colonial Heights, Hopewell, Petersburg, and Richmond, and the town of Ashland.

On March 6, 2015 (effective April 6, 2015), EPA published the final rule for the more stringent 2008 ozone NAAQS and at the same time revoked the 1997 ozone NAAQS for which the region had been in maintenance⁸. The region is currently in

attainment of all the criteria pollutants for which the EPA has established NAAQS, including the more stringent 2008 and 2015 ozone NAAQS.

3.0 Long-Range Transportation Plan and Transportation Improvement Program

This conformity assessment is being prepared for the RRTPO 2045 LRTP and FY 2021-2024 TIP, and for the TCAMPO 2040 LRTP and FY 2021-2024 TIP, although the TCAMPO is not updating nor amending their TIP or LRTP at this time. The respective project list(s) for both the RRTPO and TCAMPO LRTP and TIP are presented in Appendix B.

4.0 Transportation Conformity Determination: General Process

Pursuant to the court's decision in *South Coast II*, beginning February 16, 20199, a transportation conformity determination for the 1997 ozone NAAQS is needed in all 1997 ozone NAAQS nonattainment and maintenance areas identified by EPA¹⁰, including the Richmond area.

Accordingly, following the February 16, 2018 court ruling, a regional transportation conformity analysis¹¹ (including a regional emission analysis) was conducted for the RRTPO and TCAMPO FY 18-21 TIP and 2040 LRTP, for which a joint finding of conformity was received from FHWA and FTA on October 29, 2018. Going forward, conformity findings are needed for all updated or amended metropolitan LRTPs and TIPs and otherwise no less frequently than every four years¹².

5.0 Transportation Conformity Requirements

5.1 Overview

This conformity assessment was conducted in compliance with the federal transportation conformity rule (40 CFR Parts 51 and 93)¹³, the corresponding state transportation conformity regulation or "conformity SIP" (9 VAC 5-151)¹⁴, and local

conformity consultation procedures as amended and established pursuant to the federal and state conformity regulations¹⁵.

On November 29, 2018, EPA issued *Transportation Conformity Guidance for the South Coast II Court Decision*¹⁶ (EPA-420-B-18-050) that addresses how transportation conformity determinations can be made in "orphan" areas that were nonattainment or maintenance for the 1997 ozone NAAQS when the 1997 ozone NAAQS was revoked but were designated attainment for the 2008 ozone NAAQS in EPA's original designations for this NAAQS (May 21, 2012). Importantly, the guidance specifically states that "a regional emissions analysis is not required for conformity determinations for the 1997 ozone NAAQS because that NAAQS has been revoked (80 FR 12264)"¹⁷.

For background, the transportation conformity regulation at 40 CFR 93.109 sets forth the criteria and procedures for determining conformity. The conformity criteria for MTPs and TIPs include: latest planning assumptions (93.110), latest emissions model (93.111), consultation (93.112), transportation control measures (93.113(b) and (c), and emissions budget and/or interim emissions (93.118 and/or 93.119). For the 1997 ozone NAAQS areas, transportation conformity for MTPs and TIPs for the 1997 ozone NAAQS can be demonstrated without a regional emissions analysis, per 40 CFR 93.109(c). This provision states that the regional emissions analysis requirement applies one year after the effective date of EPA's nonattainment designation for a NAAQS and until the effective date of revocation of such NAAQS for an area. The 1997 ozone NAAQS revocation was effective on April 6, 2015, and the *South Coast II* court decision upheld the revocation. As no regional emission analysis is required for this conformity determination, there is no requirement to use the latest emissions model, or budget or interim emissions tests for orphan areas for the 1997 ozone NAAQS, including the Richmond Area.

Therefore, transportation conformity for the 1997 ozone NAAQS can be demonstrated by showing the remaining requirements in Table 1 in 40 CFR 93.109 have been met. These requirements, which are laid out in Section 2.4 of EPA's guidance and addressed below, include:

- Latest planning assumptions (93.110)
- Consultation (93.112)
- Timely Implementation of Transportation Control Measures (93.113)
- Fiscal constraint (93.108)

5.2 Latest Planning Assumptions

The use of latest planning assumptions in 40 CFR 93.110 of the conformity rule for regional emissions analyses apply generally for modeling inputs but also include assumptions about transportation control measures (TCMs) if any are included in an approved and applicable SIP. As orphan areas as defined in the South Coast II decision and per EPA guidance issued in November 2018 do not require regional emission analyses, and the 2007 SIP for the Richmond region did not include TCMs, the use of latest planning assumptions is not applicable for regional conformity determinations for this region.

5.3 Consultation

The requirements in 40 CFR 93.112 were addressed for both interagency and public consultation ¹⁸. The consultation conducted was consistent with requirements of the Virginia Conformity SIP, which closely reflects the requirements of the federal rule, as well as the Richmond inter-agency consultation procedures for conformity as previously cited. The public consultation conducted was also consistent with planning rule requirements in 23 CFR 450, as well as the RRTPO Public Participation Plan¹⁹. Copies of consultation materials are provided in Appendix A, including a copy of the conformity schedule as presented to the ICG.

5.4 Timely Implementation of TCMs

As noted above under latest planning assumptions, this requirement is not applicable for Richmond Region as the 2007 Eight-Hour Ozone SIP for Richmond Region did not include TCMs.

5.5 Fiscal Constraint

Transportation conformity requirements in 40 CFR 93.108 state that transportation plans and TIPs must be fiscally constrained consistent with DOT's metropolitan planning regulations at 23 CFR part 450. The RRTPO 2045 LRTP and FY 2021-2024 TIP are fiscally constrained, as documented in the "*Richmond Area 2045 Long-Range Transportation Plan*" and the "*Financial Plan*" section of the TIP²¹.

6.0 Conclusion

This report documents that the RRTPO 2045 LRTP and FY 2021-2024 TIP, and TCAMPO 2040 LRTP and FY 2021-2024 TIP, have met all applicable federal (40 CFR Parts 51 and 93), state and local requirements relating to transportation conformity and, accordingly, a finding of conformity for each respective LRTP and TIP is supported.

Richmond Interagency Consultation Group Meeting and Technical Advisory Committee (TAC)²²
Approvals of the Draft Conformity Report, with Inter-Agency Consultation for Conformity
(IACC)²³ and Public Consultation:

- July 1st, 2021: RRTPO approval of the fiscally-constrained FY 2021-2024 TIP and 2045 LRTP project list for conformity and authorize the TAC to approve conformity determination for public review.
- <u>July 7th, 2021:</u> Interagency Consultation Group (ICG) meeting, at which the conformity schedule and project lists for the conformity assessment were approved by the ICG. An opportunity for public input was provided at this meeting but comments were not received.
- July 7th, 2021: The RRTPO TAC approved the draft Regional Conformity Assessment and proposed finding of conformity for public review. Comments were not received on the draft report and/or the proposed finding of conformity.

<u>Note</u>: The agencies and members currently represented in the Richmond ICG, which includes all parties identified in federal and state conformity regulations, are presented in the table below.

Formal Public Review Period:

■ <u>July 9th - July 24th, 2021</u>: RRTPO fifteen day public review period on the draft Regional Conformity Assessment. A total of five adverse comments were received during the public review period. A copy of the submitted comments and the RRTPO response are attached.

RRTPO Board Approval of Draft Report, with Public Consultation

 August 5th, 2021: RRTPO Board approval of the draft Conformity Assessment and finding of conformity for submittal to FHWA, considering any comments and responses from consultation.

²² The approval process for the RRTPO generally first involves the TAC, which reviews the draft report and provides a recommendation for approval to the RRTPO Board whose meeting is generally later the same month. RRTPO Board and TAC meetings are open to the public, with announcements typically distributed by email the week before the meeting and also posted on the RRTPO website.



1. Call to Order and Introduction

Mr. Grinnell with the VDOT Environmental Division provided the presentation at today's ICG meeting. Mr. Grinnell stated the purpose of the meeting is to initiate a regional conformity assessment on the RRTPO FY 2021-2024 TIP and 2045 LRTP, and noted that the Tri-Cities MPO (TCAMPO) has certified that they are not updating or amending its FY 2021-2024 TIP and 2040 LRTP at this time.

Mr. Grinnell advised that United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit in South Coast Air Quality Mgmt. District v. EPA ("South Coast II," 882 F.3d 1138) held in its decision on February 16, 2018 that transportation conformity determinations must be made in all "orphan" areas nationwide that were either nonattainment or maintenance for the 1997 ozone NAAQS and attainment for the 2008 ozone NAAQS when the 1997 ozone NAAQS was revoked. Additionally Mr. Grinnell stated that on November 29, 2018, EPA issued South Coast II guidance that says conformity can be demonstrated without a regional emissions analysis in orphan areas. The South Coast II court decision upheld EPA's revocation of the 1997 ozone NAAQS, which was effective on April 6, 2015. EPA's current transportation conformity regulation requires a regional emissions analysis (REA) only during the time period beginning one year after a nonattainment designation for a particular NAAQS until the effective date of revocation of that NAAOS (40 CFR 93.109(c)). Therefore, pursuant to this regulation, a REA is not required for conformity determinations for the 1997 ozone NAAQS because that NAAQS has been revoked. Mr. Grinnell also stated that there must be a conforming TIP and LRTP in place and that projects must come from a conforming TIP and LRTP. In addition, fiscal constraint and interagency consultation requirements still apply.

Mr. Grinnell said that the RRTPO and TCAMPO approved the Interagency Consultation Group (ICG) procedures in October 2005, which require consultation on the schedule and constrained TIP and LRTP project list.

Project List for Conformity Analysis

The conformity project list for the TCAMPO FY 21-24 TIP and 2040 LRTP, and RRTPO FY 21-24 TIP and 2045 LRTP were emailed to the ICG prior to the meeting, and they were also included with the RRTPO Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) agenda package. The project list includes the fiscally constrained FY 21-24 TIP and 2045 LRTP projects as approved by the RRTPO, and also notes whether each project is considered to be regionally significant. The TCAMPO is not updating or amending their TIP or LRTP at this time.

Mr. Grinnell advised the conformity project list focuses on projects that are regionally significant that would normally be included within the regional travel demand model. Mr. Grinnell stated that projects that are not regionally significant may not typically be modeled and would not impact the conformity analysis. Mr. Grinnell asked that the ICG members review the projects to see if any amendments/additions need to be made.



Mr. Sulabh Aryal commented prior to the ICG meeting that the Henrico County project on line 300, Springfield Road widening, is a minor arterial and should be listed as regionally significant. The Project list was updated to reflect this request.

Mr. Sulabh Aryal also commented that the list of projects highlighted as regionally significant are generally on arterial roads or higher functional classification and did not include collectors. Mr. Ponticello responded that historically projects involving arterials or higher functional classifications have been listed as regionally significant and generally are projects that serve regional transportation needs. No additional requests to add or remove projects designated as regionally significant were made.

No additional comments were received. The members present voted unanimously to approve the conformity schedule and project list with the change noted above.

DRAFT REGIONAL CONFORMITY REPORT

Richmond Regional Transportation Planning Organization

REQUESTED ACTION: The Richmond Regional Transportation Planning Organization (RRTPO) Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) is expected to be given authority to open a public comment period on the draft regional conformity report by the RRTPO policy board at the July 1, 2021 meeting. TAC is requested to approve opening a comment period on the draft regional conformity report to run from July 9, 2020 to July 24, 2020.

BACKGROUND:

As part of the ConnectRVA 2045 plan (LRTP update), the Richmond-Petersburg Area is required to demonstrate conformity under the Clean Air Act (CAA). While in attainment for all current emissions standards, the region was a nonattainment area, and later a maintenance area, for the 1997 8-hour ozone standard. In 2018, the D.C. Circuit Court issued a decision in *South Coast Air Quality Management District v. EPA* which requires all nonattainment or maintenance areas under the 1997 standards to demonstrate conformity for the LRTP and the TIP, even when in attainment under the more stringent 2015 standards. The constrained list of projects in the ConnectRVA 2045 plan along with the ungrouped projects in the FY 21-24 TIP, will constitute the RRTPO set of projects for this analysis.

An interagency consultation meeting will be held immediately before the July 7, 2021 TAC meeting to review the process and methodology for the conformity analysis. The draft conformity analysis report will be provided prior to that meeting and will be sent to all TAC members when received. The proposed resolution opens a comment period on the conformity report as required by federal regulations.

TAC ACTION REQUESTED: The following resolution is presented for TAC approval:

RESOLVED, that the Richmond Regional Transportation Planning Organization opens a 15-day comment period for public review and input on the draft regional conformity report to run between July 9, 2021 and July 24, 2021.

Public Comments - Draft Regional Conformity Report (July 9 - July 24)

Comment #1

Message: No funding dollars should be spent on infrastructure for private cars; this includes new highways, more roads, larger intersections, highway expansions, wider roads, and more parking. Not only are all these are antithetical to clean air and will only exacerbate the global climate crisis we are in, it will only serve to increase car dependence in our region. A robust public transportation system needs to be implemented in our region. Better transportation alternatives need to be implemented in our region. If we follow the same bad playbook as every other region (Northern Virginia, the Tidewater area), we will end up just like them: chocked in roads and bad traffic.

RRTPO Response: Thank you for your constructive feedback. RRTPO supports multimodal transportation investment and that is reflected in the plan. The plan includes alternate transportation investments like the Richmond region's north-south shared use path (the Fall Line trail) as well as multijurisdictional BRT and enhanced transit routes. Out of all the known active transportation projects suggested as part of the Universe of Projects, 97% were included in the cost-possible plan. ConnectRVA 2045 is a need-based plan. There are unmet highway needs in the region which the plan addresses, and these highway projects are in line with locality priorities. The plan is updated every five years and as regional priorities change so do the projects listed in the plan.

Comment #2

Message: It is gratifying to see so many public transportation and bike/pedestrian projects on the draft Air Quality Conformity Report. They will all help improve the air quality of the region. One would hope that many of the regionally significant road widening projects would also include the construction of sidewalks. The League of Women Voters of the Richmond Metropolitan Area supports multi-modal transportation, which includes walking and bicycling, and public transportation. The national League of Women Voters supports air pollution controls (See Impact on Issues, p. 98 https://www.lwv.org/sites/default/files/2020-12/LWV-impact-2020.pdf.)

RRTPO Response: Thank you for your constructive feedback. Many regionally significant road widening projects in the Richmond region include bike and pedestrian accommodations like sidewalks, crosswalks and bike lanes.

Comment #3

Message: I am incredibly disappointed that so much of this money is going to projects that harm air quality. Additionally, the building of highways instead of better transit options (busses, bike lanes) is a deep point of concern. To add to this, I am surprised and frustrated that the suburban county of Henrico that already is very difficult to move within without a car is getting so much regional transit money and spending so little of it to improve mobility for lower income people. The lack of useful service between Richmond and Henrico requires people to own cars throughout Henrico, thereby negatively impacting the air quality of neighborhoods. I live in the city of Richmond on a bus line and work in Henrico County. It would take me 50 minutes via bus (instead of 15 via car) to get to my office (also on a bus line). I would also love to bike to work but can't do so during the workday as it is so very unsafe. Building better interchange between Richmond and Henrico specifically would allow for more people to use busses and bikes to commute rather than cars. This would be better for the overall health and mobility of the region as well as air quality (due to a decreased reliance on cars).

RRTPO Response: Thank you for your feedback. RRTPO supports multimodal transportation investment, including transit. The plan includes capital investments for four multijurisdictional enhanced transit (15-minute service frequency) routes and one bus rapid transit (BRT) route and well as one major transfer station and two neighborhood transfer stations. Four of the new enhanced transit or BRT routes will be routes from Richmond to Henrico County.

Regarding air quality, the Richmond region is currently meeting all of EPA's air quality standards, including those for ozone and fine particulate matter. ConnectRVA 2045 is not anticipated to cause or contribute to a violation of any air quality standards. The Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (VDEQ) maintains a network of air quality monitors throughout the Commonwealth, and current data can be viewed at https://www.deq.virginia.gov/air/monitoring-assessments/air-monitoring/pollutant-monitoring.

Comment #4

Message: The plan is wonderful. Apparently, the people who oppose it never go anywhere unless they can walk or bike.

Comment #5

Message: The allocation percentage to roads is too high. Please allocate more to shared transportation, bike and pedestrian options.

RRTPO Response: Thank you for your constructive feedback. ConnectRVA 2045 is a need-based plan. Allocation of transportation dollars are based on the current regional need and local jurisdiction priorities. As a matter of comparison, out of all the possible projects that were developed in each category, 97% of active transportation projects are included in the final plan while only 80% of highway projects are included in the final plan. The plan is updated every five years and as regional priorities change over time so will the allocation percentage to different transportation modes.

Comment #6

Message: I am surprised to read that a plan where one quarter of all the projects explicitly add capacity for more cars in the region passes any kind of air quality assessment -- on the face of it, that\'s just not credible. And that\'s before taking into account the dollar value of these projects compared to potential alternatives, and the reality that many of the \"safety\" projects are primarily operational changes that will add capacity, and that several new roads and added capacity on smaller roads are not even assessed. We should not be adding any more capacity for cars. Period.

RRTPO Response: Thank you for your constructive feedback. RRTPO supports multimodal transportation investment which includes all transportation modes including highway, transit, active transportation, freight and passenger rail. Along with transit, active transportation, freight and passenger rail needs, there are unmet highway needs, aligned with the locality priorities which ConnectRVA 2045 addresses.

Regarding air quality, the Richmond region is currently meeting all of EPA's air quality standards, including those for ozone and fine particulate matter. ConnectRVA 2045 is not anticipated to cause or contribute to a violation of any air quality standards. The Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (VDEQ) maintains a network of air quality monitors throughout the Commonwealth, and current data can be viewed at https://www.deq.virginia.gov/air/monitoring-assessments/air-monitoring/pollutant-monitoring.
