1. Introduction & Overview

- United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit in South Coast Air Quality Mgmt. District v. EPA ("South Coast II," 882 F.3d 1138) held in its decision on February 16, 2018 that transportation conformity determinations must be made in all areas nation-wide that were either nonattainment or maintenance for the 1997 ozone NAAQS and attainment for the 2008 ozone NAAQS when the 1997 ozone NAAQS was revoked.
- The reinstated conformity requirements were subsequently made effective February 16, 2019.
- November 29, 2018, EPA issued Transportation Conformity Guidance for the South Coast II Court Decision states;
 - "...a regional emissions analysis is not required for conformity determinations for the 1997 ozone NAAQS because that NAAQS has been revoked (80 FR 12264)."

1. Introduction & Overview Continued

- Interagency consultation is required by the Clean Air Act and Transportation Conformity Rule
 - ICG Membership specified by agency
 - RRTPO and TCAMPO approved Consultation Procedures in October 2005
- Consultation required for:
 - Schedule
 - Project lists for the conformity analysis
- Focus on TCAMPO FY 21-24 TIP and 2045 LRTP, as RRTPO is not amending/updating its TIP/LRTP at this time.

3(a). Conformity Assessment Schedule

Date	Task
January 13 th , 2022	TCAMPO approved the fiscally-constrained FY21-24 TIP and 2045 LRTP project list for conformity and authorized the TAC to approve the draft regional conformity assessment for public review
February 8 th , 2022	Interagency Consultation Group (ICG) Meeting on the FY21-24 TIP and 2045 LRTP regional conformity assessment.
March 4 th , 2022	TCAMPO TAC approves the draft regional conformity assessment for public review
March 7 th - April 6 th , 2022	30-day public comment period on the draft regional conformity assessment
April 7 th -11 th , 2022	VDOT/PDC staff review and address public comments (if necessary)
April 14 th , 2022	TCAMPO approves the final regional conformity assessment for submittal to FHWA
April 15 th , 2022	VDOT submits e-copy of final regional conformity assessment to FHWA; 45-day federal review period begins
May 30 th , 2022	Federal Conformity Determination received

3(b). Project Lists for Conformity Analysis

- The conformity project list focuses on projects that are regionally significant and would normally be included in the transportation demand modeling network
 - Regionally Significant project means a transportation project (other than an exempt project) that is on a facility which serves regional transportation needs (such as access to and from the area outside of the region, major activity centers in the region, major planned developments such as new retail malls, sports complexes, etc., or transportation terminals as well as most terminals themselves) and would normally be included in the modeling of a metropolitan area's transportation network, including at a minimum all principal arterial highways and all fixed guideway transit facilities that offer an alternative to regional highway travel.
- Projects not regionally significant or not typically modeled are not necessarily identified on this list
