1. STATEMENT REGARDING VIRTUAL MEETINGS

Chet Parsons, PlanRVA, shared the statement on virtual meetings.

Interagency Consultation Group (ICG) meeting – Tri-Cities MPO

Daniel Grinnell, VDOT and Ronald Svejkovsky, Tri-Cities MPO, opened the ICG portion of the meeting at 9:00 a.m. and provided presentations on the following:

Members of the Tri-Cities MPO voted to approve the membership update, conformity schedule and modifying the conformity project list.

CALL TO ORDER

Following the ICG meeting, the Richmond Regional Transportation Planning Organization (RRTPO) Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) Vice-chair, Sharon Smidler, presided and called the February 8, 2022, RRTPO TAC meeting to order at 9:17 a.m.

ATTENDANCE ROLL CALL & CERTIFICATION OF MEETING QUORUM

Janice Firestone, Program Coordinator, took attendance by roll call and certified that a quorum was present.

2. Consideration of Amendments to the Action Meeting Agenda

Chet Parsons, PlanRVA, presented two amendments to the agenda for consideration: correction of Item 7 to read **FY23 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) Priorities** and removal of Item 12 - **Smart Scale Regional Project Selections** (a special meeting will be held at a later date for consideration of that matter).

On motion of Dironna Moore Clarke, seconded by Joseph E. Vidunas, the RRTPO Technical Advisory Committee unanimously approved the February 8, 2022, agenda as amended (see <u>Appendix A</u>):

Tara FitzPatrick, Safe Routes to School Coordinator for Greater Richmond Fit4Kids, addressed the committee and expressed her appreciation to PlanRVA staff for their help with her agency's Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) grant application.

6. **RRTPO Update**

a. Current Work Efforts (a copy of this document can be found in the agenda packet)

Mr. Parsons gave this report to the committee and announced that the public review period for the BikePedRVA 2045 draft plan will open tomorrow. He asked members to share the information and encourage participation.

7. FY23 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) Priorities (a copy of this document can be found in the agenda packet)

Mr. Parsons gave an overview of the plan and explained that it is updated annually. The four core program areas were explained.

10. <u>FTA 5310 application endorsement</u> (a copy of this document can be found in the agenda packet)

Ken Lantz, PlanRVA, presented this request to the committee.

On motion of Barbara K. Smith, seconded by Nora Amos, the RRTPO Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) voted unanimously to recommend RRTPO Policy Board approval of the following resolution as presented (see <u>Appendix A</u>):

RESOLVED, that the Richmond Regional Transportation Planning Organization Policy Board endorses the following applications for Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5310 funds:

- Chesterfield County Community Citizen Information and Resources Mobility Services: Operating assistance and to support the cost of trips, \$533,600;
- Chesterfield Community Mental Health Services Board: Purchase two (2) 15passenger body on chassis vans with wheelchair lifts, \$130,000;
- Goochland CARES: Purchase one (1) 14-passenger van with wheelchair lift, \$65,000
- Hanover DASH: Provide and expand specialized transportation for non-driver older adults and individuals with disabilities, \$750,000;
- Senior Connections: Provide mobility management and transportation services for older adults and persons with disabilities, \$305,600
- GRTC: Provide travel training assistance for individuals, particularly seniors and person with disabilities, \$150,000.

Resolved, that the Richmond Regional Transportation Planning Organization (RRTPO) approves the transfer of \$88,857 in previous regional Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) and match funds from the balance entry (UPC 70721) to the Rt 155 Shared Use Path project (UPC 97688),

b. GRTC

Sam Sink, Director of Planning and Scheduling, at GRTC, noted that Nick Britton would be providing an update on the GRTC Micro-transit Study. Mr. Britton gave an overview of what micro-transit is and reported on the study progress to date. Adrienne Torres, Chief Development Officer at GRTC, noted that they are hoping to start scheduling the meetings with jurisdictions right away.

Mr. Britton clarified that the VDOT MetroQuest Survey period should have ended in December.

c. <u>RideFinders</u>

John O'Keeffe, Account Executive at RideFinders, provided an update on RideFinders activities.

d. <u>VDOT</u>

Nicole Mueller, Planning Specialist at VDOT, provided an update on VDOT activities.
