#### FY22 – FY27 RSTBG/CMAQ DRAFT ALLOCATIONS

#### **Richmond Regional Transportation Planning Organization**

**REQUESTED ACTION:** Review, input, and recommendation to the RRTPO Policy Board of the RSTBG and CMAQ allocation plans.

**BACKGROUND**: Selecting and prioritizing projects for funding through suballocated grants like RSTBG and CMAQ is one of the primary roles of the RRTPO in developing the regional transportation system. Projects selected by the RRTPO to receive funding are included in the Six-Year Improvement Program (SYIP) for adoption by the Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB).

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, revenues for transportation have been significantly reduced for the FY22 – FY27 SYIP. A comparison table of the expected allocations based on the allocation plans approved in September 2020 and the actual available allocations received February 25<sup>th</sup> is provided in *Attachment A* for each program.

For CMAQ, expected allocations have been reduced by \$6,870,585, or 13.2%, with annual reductions ranging from \$740,264 in FY23 to \$1,375,416 in FY26. For the RSTBG program, the reductions for the FY22 – FY27 period total \$15,901,338, or 12.6%, from the expected allocations level. Annual reductions range from \$2,503,758 in FY22 to \$2,848,217 in FY26.

**ALLOCATIONS APPROACH:** Due to the significant decrease in available allocations, staff has worked with VDOT to develop allocation plans focused on preserving existing projects and no new projects are recommended for funding in the draft plans. A balance has been retained for the outyears at a significantly reduced level to cover cost increases or further funding reductions and to allow for new project selection in future cycles. The balance held in reserve was reduced from previous levels by \$2.1M for CMAQ and \$7.2M for RSTBG.

In developing the draft plans, priority in funding was given to projects which are closer to completion. The draft plans maintain the schedules for all CMAQ projects with funding in the FY22 – FY27 period. For RSTBG, all but one (1) project receiving allocations in the FY22 – FY27 plan are kept on schedule.

**<u>UNFUNDED BALANCES</u>**: While all project schedules are preserved, the draft plan leaves unfunded balances for several projects in each program. A summary of projects with unfunded balances is included in *Attachment B*.

For the CMAQ program, the unfunded balances are largely future phase of projects which will be allocated in FY28 or FY29 based on the project schedule. The needed funding can be addressed in future allocation cycles as part of the normal allocation process.

The RSTBG program presents more fiscal challenges from unfunded balances. Based on the proposed schedules, RRTPO staff expect \$18.2M in allocations will be needed for FY28, nearly the entire expected available allocations.

In addition to the projects with future phases beyond the six-year plan, two other projects have \$6.3M in balance for which the TPO has not received an application. These represent potential future requests which may need to be addressed in future cycles.

Finally, the Mayo Bridge Rehabilitation project (UPC 104888) represents a third category of unfunded balance. The project sponsor submitted a request for an additional funding for the project this cycle which was not funded. The VDOT estimate (\$18.3M) is \$5.2M higher than the locality estimate (\$13.1M) provided in the request, giving a range for the total unfunded balance between \$4.3M and \$9.5M.

**<u>RRTPO STAFF RECOMMENDATION</u>**: Staff recommends following the allocations approach outlined above, with a focus on preserving existing projects. The proposed allocations plan for CMAQ funds is found in *Attachment C* and the proposed allocations plan for RSTBG funds is found in *Attachment D*.

A request was received from Hanover to include \$4,378,839 in FY27 funding for UPC 115195 – Atlee Station Widening in the RSTBG plan. This allocation was expected for FY27 but was erroneously left off the draft allocation plan as a local contribution/no post pending this final allocation made the project appear fully funded during the initial review with VDOT. The revised plan in *Attachment D* includes funding for this project and reduces the balance held in reserve for FY26 and FY27.

Given the significant unfunded balances in the RSTBG program, staff recommends that TAC consider limiting the FY23 – FY28 application cycle for RSTBG to existing project requests only to ensure adequate funding is available to address the existing needs. Further reduction of the reserve held in balance entry will likely be required next cycle. A table summarizing the amount of funding expected to be available for new projects is included in *Attachment E*.

**TAC REQUESTED ACTION:** TAC is requested to provide a recommendation to the policy board on the following resolution:

The Richmond Regional Transportation Planning Organization (RRTPO) approves the allocation of Regional Surface Transportation Block Grant (RSTBG) and Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funds as presented.
