- <u>SMART SCALE Round 6 (FY26 FY31 SYIP)</u>
  - Pre-application closed on April 1, 2024.
    - 1. We received 79 pre-applications from Richmond District applicants.
    - 2. Approx. 24% of statewide pre-applications (327 pre-applications statewide).
    - 3. Upcoming SMART SCALE Milestones:
      - April 30<sup>th</sup> District review complete
      - May 24<sup>th</sup> Central Office review complete
      - June 1<sup>st</sup> Full applications are open for continued development
      - July15th ALL READINESS REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION DUE
      - August 1<sup>st</sup> Application submission deadline
  - Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP)
  - Transportation Alternatives selections will be presented publicly in Spring 2024.

- Fall Line
  - VDOT Design-Build Packages
    - DB#1 (Holly Hill Rd to Walder Ln; includes Chickahominy River crossing, UPC 121374)
      - Groundbreaking ceremony is tentatively scheduled for April 23, 2024.
        Construction is anticipated to begin in Spring 2024.
      - DB#2 (Patton Park to W Hundred Rd/Chester Linear Park, UPC 121511)
      - Alignment has been finalized.
      - RFP advertisement is anticipated for September 2024.
- I-64 GAP Widening
  - Segment A MM 204.9 to MM 215.6 in New Kent County (UPC 122805)
     Estimated completion of this section is Summer 2027
  - Segment B MM 215.6 to MM 224.3 in New Kent County (UPC 123831)
    - VDOT anticipates releasing the RFP in the Summer of 2024
       Estimated completion of this section is Spring / Summer 2028
  - Segment C MM 224.3 to MM 233.3 in James City County/Hampton Roads District (UPC 123129 & 123832)
    - Request for Proposals (RFP) released in November 2023
    - Scheduled for CTB Award in April 2024
    - Estimated completion of this section is Fall 2027
